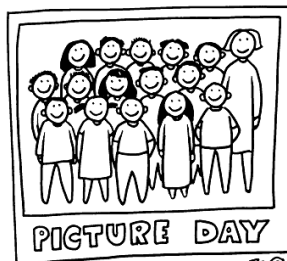

NO PARKING IN THE FRONT PARKING LOT! That area is to be used for bus loading and unloading. If you are picking your child up from school, please wait outside the front doors.

DISMISSAL - Students will not be released to anyone other than a parent without a note or call from the parent. We must have a note or call if they are to ride another bus (home with another student, daycare, etc.). If you wish to pick your child up after school, be on time. If we do not hear otherwise, your child will be put on the bus. If you need to pick your child up mid-day, you must come to the office to sign them out. Office personnel will get your child for you. For safety reasons, all doors are kept locked.

ABSENCES – Please call the office before 9:00 a.m. if your child will be absent (984-2342) Mrs. Huck will be available by 7:30 a.m. You may leave a message at any time. We also need a written excuse or doctor's slip when student returns. If we do not hear from you, office personnel will call you at home or work. If we cannot contact you, the absence will be unexcused.

NOTES FROM OUR NURSE-

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

- ✓ Mild virus characterized by red spots on the hands and feet that can progress to blisters
- ✓ Blisters/sores may be present in mouth
- ✓ May be fevered in the initial phase
- ✓ *Only* exclude for fever
- ✓ Most contagious for about 2 days before and 2 days after exposure
- ✓ Saliva is the main source of spreading for about 1-2 weeks then the virus is present in the stool for about a month.
- ✓ *The common cold is easier to catch from your 'neighbor'!*
