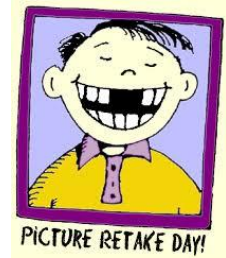
Antique Appraisals
